CARIBOO RACEWAY PARK TRACK RULES

The applicant agrees to follow the criteria below for all PRACTICE and TEST and TUNING sessions:

- 1. Testing and tuning is an on-track activity that does not involve wheel-to-wheel competition, races of any kind, or rewards of any kind.
- **2.** During Testing and Tuning sessions, the track must be supervised at all times it is being used, regardless of the number of karts or bikes on the track. For clarity, it is not permitted that a single person alone can take a kart or bike onto the race track without a first-aid trained club senior supervisor present.
- **3.** Testing and Tuning is available only to permanent and temporary (daily) members in good standing of an affiliated club who individually have signed a waiver.
- **4.** All participants, not just the driver, must sign a waiver and release, preferably an ASN annual release with membership, or each time the race track facility is used.
- **5.** Parent/Guardian release waivers are applicable where minors are involved.
- **6.** No more than 10 karts or bikes on the race track at one time and never together.
- **7.** Wheel-to wheel competition is not permitted.
- **8.** Non-competitive passing is allowed.
- **9.** A person (Supervisor) who is not the driver of a kart or bike on the track must supervise the activity on the track.
- **10.** The Supervisor must be able to call 911. A connected land line or functioning cellular phone is permitted.
- 11. A fire extinguisher and first aid kit must be accessible by the supervisor.
- **12.** A vehicle must be readily available to the Supervisor to provide assistance where necessary while awaiting response from a 911 call.

Other general rules for Cariboo Raceway Park

- Each vehicle must pass a safety inspection before entering the race track. E.g. Brakes, steering components, throttle cables, fuel lines and tanks, tires, secondary fasteners, exhaust components, bumpers and side pods.
- Each person must have and wear proper safety equipment. Full face Schnell approved helmets, gloves, scuff resistant full coverage clothing, rib protectors, footwear with full coverage, (no exposed skin) neck collars are voluntary.
- There is zero tolerance for any alcohol or illegal drugs during any testing or racing sessions at Cariboo Raceway Park.
- No unleashed pets allowed in the park during testing or racing sessions.
- No refueling or oil changing of any kind on the asphalt surface in the pit area. Refuel or oil changing on the gravel area of your pit area with proper spill containment.
- No smoking or fires in your pit area when refueling.
- Clean-up your pit area after your session.
- Push your bikes or karts in the pit area.
- Do-not speed through the grid area.
- Shut off your kart or bike and push it up onto the scales. Do not drive up on the scales as it will damage them.
- Raise one hand when entering or leaving the track.
- Raise both hands if you are stopped on the track. This lets us know you are OK.
- The pit wall is a protective structure. Sitting on it is unsafe to you and the drivers on the other side. Keep off the wall.
- If your child or grandchild has an incident on the track **DO-NOT** blindly run out on the track to assist. The track marshal is fully capable to organize a stop of the race and direct first-aid to an incident.
