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Supplemental Rules for SIKA Race 2 - 3, May 1 - 2, 2004

- 1. Races are open to SIKA club members and holders of BCKCA and ASN driver's licenses.
- 2. Fuel source for FR125 is Chevron at 3305 32nd Street, 94 octane.
- 3. Fuel source for S4 is Chevron at $3305 32^{nd}$ Street, 87 octane.
- 4. BCKCA Tech Rule 8:20 does not apply for SIKA Club Races (full width rear bumpers are permitted but not required).
- 5. ASN Tech Rule 21.9 does not apply for SIKA Club Races (coatings on Honda 4 cycle engine heads are not prohibited).
- 6. Junior 3 2 cycle (J32) class will not be run at this event.
- 7. Practice group order will follow Race Group sequence.
- 8. FR125 will be split into A and B flights if the entry level exceeds 18 entries. The top-scoring portion from the qualifying heats of both flights will qualify for the A Main. The balance will qualify for the B Main. A top-scoring portion from the B Main will earn a transfer to the A Main. Finishing positions for the B Main will be scored following those for the A Main. The number of transfer positions will be based on entry level and track capacity. This will be announced before the heats for the day.
- 9. Karts must conform to one of the above 9 listed classes (J14, J24, J22, FR125J, S4, FR125, TAG, SC, or OP) to run at this event.
- 10. The Open class is not a scored class. The entries in this class may be split into two groups, with World Formula engines being run in Group 4 and ICA Restricted engines being run in Group 7.
- 11. Tardiness of the race Groups reporting for marshal duty when called, will result in the shortening of that groups heat length.
- 12. Qualifying Heat lengths are 16 laps.
- 13. Main Heat length is 20 laps (time permitting).
- 14. ASN Canada flag and sign rules will apply.
